- Looking to explore? We recommend walking around the Telliskivi area which is a creative Hub and the Hipster Central in Tallinn.
- Just 5min from the hotel is a panoramic Cruise Terminal Promenade we recommend this for the morning people.
- For moving around in Tallinn we highly recommend to use Bolt app. This is by far the most popular taxi ordering apps in Estonia, also allows to rent scooters, bikes, order food. Uber is available but with fewer cars and more expensive.
- If you get a regular taxi from the street, be sure to agree on the price before starting the ride. If you are at the hotel, ask the reception to get you a taxi.
